I have ordered black light strips for my classroom, and I tape them up around the top of the room, and then I've also gotten some black out curtains. Some activities I've done include: drumming with sticks that have UV reflective tape, mirroring with neon scarves. reading rhythms written on paper with highlighter, and writing rhythms with cut up neon straws. The options are endless.

Some things to consider:

- Not all neon or white glows
- Get a black light flash light to take to the store to check and see if the material will respond to the black light.
