Hand Drum Storage

Is instrument storage difficult to manage in your classroom? If you're like me, you have to get really creative to utilize every nook and cranny! After watching Marie Kondo's "Tidying Up" on Netflix, I began to think outside the box in terms of my storage at school. I unfortunately have very little cabinet space and do not have access to a closet. So in order to utilize my room effectively, I make great use of my wall space!

For the longest time, my hand drums sadly lived in a plastic storage container. Now they are happily displayed on my a large wall! My students marvel at it and are very respectful of the display.

One only needs a package of command hooks (I used 3M clear hooks) and small garage sale stickers. Make sure to hold each command hook for at least 30 seconds to ensure longevity. Additionally, I used the garage sale stickers to color code each drum to its own hook based on size. So far, it's been very successful and practical in my classroom!
