

Growing a Musical Garden

Kindergarten Sol-Mi Solo Singing



Process:

- Teach the song through echo imitation
- As a class, brain storm different flowers or plants children might see in gardens.
- Together sing through these different plants/flowers.
- Have students pick their own plant/flower either from the list or a new idea.
- Practice as a group singing their plant/flower on Sol-Mi as a complete sentence.
 - Example: "I have a tulip"
- Pass out different colored scarves to each student.
- Have students bunch the scarf in their hands and slowly open to show a growing flower or plant.
- As a class, sing the song as an "A" section and students individually sing their plant or flower and show their growing flower with their scarf.
 - Have 4 students solo sing as alternating sections.
- The activity continues until everyone has had a turn singing and showing their flower or plant.

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
