



**Did you know there is a “World RPS Society?!”**

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One of my favorite activities to facilitate all year long is found in GAMEPLAN 3 in the month of March. It is a variation on the game “Rock, Paper, Scissors,” called “Leprechauns, Wizards, and Giants.” Students make a statue of each shape and it becomes an elimination game with a single winner. My students will play this game for the entire class period if I let them and it is always chosen at the end of the year when we go back and pick some of our favorites to review. I encourage to check this game out on page 98 of Jeff Kriske and Randy Delelles’ book.



What other variations are there on this game? How do your students use rock, paper, scissors in your classroom or in other areas of the school? Maybe you could encourage a particularly creative class to make up their own style of the game, “music class” version?
