

# Specials Rule!

The end of the year is so close, yet so far away in March! We use this song to get reenergized and excited about getting to go to specials.

### Process:

- Teach melody using solfege or words
- Using rhythmic building bricks, make a list of everything kids love about coming to music
  - o EX: Singing (ta, ta), Instruments (ti-ti, ta), Dancing (ta, ta), Tubanos (ta, ti-ti)
- In small groups, have the kids create word chains to use as contrasting sections
- Perform in a rondo!

### Extensions:

- Add barred instruments for A section
- Add unpitched percussion for word chains
- Use word chains for vocal or barred instrument improvisation
- Create other lyrics to go with other specials
