October Listening

Adapted lesson from Roger Sams Music is Elementary

Level: 3rd-5th (depending on ability)


Objectives: Form, solfege, contour, layered speech ostinati, movement, improvisation, pitched/unpitched percussion

Process

1. Students clap/read the following rhythm excerpt:



- 2. Use the solfa tone ladder to prepare students for the pitch vocabulary of the song
 - a. Students read and sing the song using solfa syllables
 - b. Acclimate the students to the pitches of the song on the staff
 - c. Students read from the staff and sing the song using solfa syllables



3. Students sing the song with text while reading from the staff



Pathway to Part Work:

- 1. Teach speech ostinato by rote one at a time
- 2. Students create gestural movement for the speech ostinato
- 3. Divide the class into three groups. Layer the speech and movement ostinato in one at a time
- 4. Perform in ABA form
 - a. Sing song
 - b. Layered speech/movement ostinato
 - c. Sing song
