Using the app Doceri

If you are fortunate to have one-to-one devices in your district, I would suggest checking out the Doceri app. This app is an interactive whiteboard. I have used it to write on PowerPoint/Google Slides and other activities. Since COVID-19 has hit, I have had my students use this app as an interactive whiteboard to write out their own rhythms. They can choose a 5-Line Staff background to practice their Treble Clef notes. Students are able to do multiple pages for whatever music activity you give them, and they can record on it. If you have remote students, they can use this to write on and send a screenshot of their work to you through email. There are endless possibilities for this interactive whiteboard!
